

## FX1200e Makes Debut at Labelexpo



Primera brought its tabletop CX1200e to Labelexpo Europe along with its new companion, the FX1200e finishing system.

"Labelexpo Europe was a huge success for us. We didn't think that our first time attendance in 2009 could be topped, but this year's show did it," said managing director Andreas Hoffmann. "Our stand was crowded all day long with high-qualified visitors that wanted to see our machines running."

The FX unit allows for lamination, die-cutting, matrix removal, slitting, and rewinding. Cutting is accomplished by up to four knife blades. The finisher moves at 6.1 meter per minute, as will a typical cut job. Of course, the more intricate the cut, the longer it takes.

Besides the CX-FX combo new products were introduced as well, for example the new CX1000e that prints on pre-die cut labels. But the product won't be available before first quarter of 2012.

"Labelexpo is the perfect show for our products and the success speaks for itself. Therefore, we already rebooked for 2013 with a stand double the size of this year."
